Ministry Home Rules and Regulations

General House Rules

- 1. Make your beds first thing in the morning.
- 2. Do not wear or touch anything that is not yours without owner's permission. If owner is not home, you may not use it.
- 3. Everyone does laundry and folds clothes. Clothes must be put up neatly at all times.
- 4. When you use the restrooms, take a bath, cut hair, shave, etc. leave the room the way you found it or better.
- 5. Please sit on furniture properly.
- 6. Everyone is expected to keep the house looking clean.
- 7. Absolutely NO phone calls after 10:00 p.m.
- 8. No secular music.
- 9. Always clean up after yourself promptly.
- 10. Everyone goes to church Sunday mornings at 9:45 a.m.
- 11. Everyone participates in daily devotionals.
- 12. Respect other's belongings.
- 13. No smoking.
- 14. Jesus lives here. Encourage his presence.

Class A --- No Tolerance Rules

- 1. Being under the influence of or in possession of any intoxicants, illegal substances, alcohol, drugs, or cigarettes is strictly forbidden.
- 2. Threatening or intimidating any resident or staff member will not be tolerated. Physical violence is strictly forbidden.
- 3. Residents are expected to accept and submit to all disciplinary action deemed necessary by the Director and must attend required meetings and activities. Open rebellion & disobedience will not be tolerated.
- 4. Sexual offenses are not tolerated.
- 5. Stealing is not tolerated.
- 6. Discipline will be immediate, with the resident being subject to dismissal on the first offense. Dismissal is mandatory on the second offense.

Ministry Homes Rules and Regulations

<u>Class B --- General expectations</u>

- 1. Residents will be required to adhere to all rules and regulations of the program. Resistance and disobedience towards staff is not permitted.
- 2. Continuous arguing with other residence or staff will not be allowed. Swearing, cursing or foul language is strictly forbidden.
- 3. Conversation will be edifying while residing at S.O.S. homes. Talk of the past life, murmuring, grumbling and disrespect are not permitted.
- 4. Residents are expected to be on good behavior at all times.
- 5. Dress is to be clean and modest.
- 6. Only Christian music may be listened to, sung or played.
- 7. General Performance: Residents will be expected to work diligently, do chores faithfully and to participate in worship and other activities with a positive mental attitude. Residents must keep cooperative attitude in order to help themselves and others receive full benefit from the program.
- 8. You are expected to participate in every activity pertaining to the ministry.
- 9. By coming to the ministry, you are willingly placing your self under the authority of the ministry.
- 10. All new residents must work on the Lawn Service.
- 11. Phone calls are limited to five minutes. All calls are to end at 10:00 p.m. weekdays and 11:00 p.m. on weekends. All calls are subject to approval of S.O.S. staff.
- 12. You are expected to have a daily devotional of at least 5 minutes. This is a vital part of your growth as a Christian.
- 13. If you leave the home voluntarily or due to disciplinary action, you will not be considered for readmission for ninety days.
- 14. Curfew on weekdays is 10:00 p.m. Weekends curfew is at midnight.
- 15. No member of the opposite sex is allowed in the ministry home without ministry consent.
- 16. You are not allowed to leave the premises without consent of a director.
- 17. No dating is permitted.
- 18. No personal cell phones.

Disciplinary action will be automatic, with the degree varying according to the nature of the offense & it's frequency. <u>Persistent offenders will be dismissed after three offenses.</u>

<u>Lawn & Landscaping Safety Manual</u> (Work program)

- At least once a month we will have safety meetings. All new employees must go over safety manual and receive a copy.
- Must wear seatbelts in all moving lawn equipment or vehicles if they are equip with seat belts.
- Safety glasses, gloves and ear plugs must be worn at all times during operation of any lawn service equipment.
- Always have safety flaps of mowers down and safety switches always operating.
- Never put hands or feet near or under lawn mower decks while equipment is on.
- Turn off equipment when putting gas.
- Turn off weed eater or edger's when changing blades.
- Turn off mower's, remove key and unplug the spark plug when changing blades or doing maintenance of all lawn equipment.
