Nursery:

The S.O.S. Nursery is in need of volunteers to help monitor nursery age children every Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday night. Volunteers will play and provide snack for the children who are less than 5 years of age.

Children's Ministry:

Monday nights from 6:30-8:30 p.m. is when we serve children in Kindergarten-6th grade in the SOS Children's Ministry. Volunteers help with leading Bible study, facilitating crafts, games & dinner. One of the things we cherish the most about this time is the relationships that are built. Volunteers often eat lunch with the kids at their schools, hang out with them around town, and take them to Sunday services at their home churches.

On Location:

During the summer time S.O.S. Children's Ministry is in need of volunteers to help out with a special four week outreach. During this outreach S.O.S. Volunteers go to "at risk" neighborhoods where they help facilitate games, crafts, snacks, and lessons.

Teenage Boy's Ministry:

We hold a Teenage Boy's Bible study every Thursday night where the young men are taught relevant Biblical truths, and how to directly apply them to their lives. At the end of this Bible study they come together for a time of fellowship and play basketball or football. S.O.S. Ministries also takes our youth on various activities throughout the year. They have an opportunity to go on a weekend camping trip, fishing trips, and much more. Volunteers will mentor and assist in leading the boys on Thursday nights.

Teenage Girl's Ministry:

We hold a Teenage Girl's Bible study every Thursday night where the young women are taught relevant Biblical truths, and how to directly apply them to their lives. The girls are also disciplined by volunteers as they are disciplined by the Teen Girls Director. We also take our girls on many fun and exciting activities. They have an opportunity to go on a weekend camping trip, a Girls Retreat, and much more. Volunteers will mentor and assist in leading the girls on Thursday nights.

Adult Ministry:

The adult ministry provides an atmosphere that makes everyone feel welcomed. We have a diverse audience both young and old, rich and poor that all come together for one purpose; to grow in Christ. We hold a weekly adult Bible study led by J.J. Ramirez every Thursday night, as well as a men's Bible study and women's Bible study on Tuesday nights. The Tuesday night Bible studies provide a more intimate setting, where relationships are built and healing occurs.

After School Program:

The After School Program helps keep kids off the streets 3:45-5:00 p.m. Mondays through Friday. Our goal is to teach them Bible studies, leadership skills, provide academic tutoring & have classes in skills such as cooking, gardening, guitar & dance. Volunteers help lead these activities and build relationships with kids in Kindergarten-6th grade. Volunteers are able to serve as many days in the week as they are able to.

S.O.S. Hearne:

SOS has expanded its Children's Ministry to Hearne. Each Wednesday night we take a team of volunteers from 6:00-8:30 p.m. to pick up kids in the neighborhoods & bring them to a local church. Volunteers will teach a Bible lesson, play games, give a snack, and make a craft. Just as in Bryan, what we cherish the most about this time is the relationships that are built.

Worship Team:

If you can play an instrument and are interested in playing with our worship team on Friday Nights, please let us know! Team members sign up on a week by week commitment. They are required to attend Tuesday night rehearsal at 7:00 the same week of the Friday Night Worship service they will be playing.

Vocational Training Program:

Volunteers help teach skills as well as disciple the men who come on Monday & Tuesday evenings from 6:00-9:00 p.m. for the vocational training classes. On these evenings, men participate in classes including plumbing & welding where they also learn life skills such as financial management to become more employable and skilled workers.

Bus Ministry:

Our Bus Ministry provides transportation for our kids to and from S.O.S. activities. We currently have two school busses as well as two vans that go out multiple times during the week. While the buses and volunteers are in the neighborhoods picking up the kids, relationships are built with the parents of our kids. We not only need drivers for these buses, but we also need monitors to sit with the kids while traveling to and from S.O.S. activities.

In the event I am engaged, I understand that all employees/volunteers are subject to termination at the discretion of the Ministry. If, in the event I choose to voluntarily terminate my service, I am free to do so at any time, and if I choose to give notice of termination, the Ministry may either permit me to continue my service during the period or may accept my resignation immediately.

I understand that, if engaged, any misrepresentation made by me in completing this application shall be considered as sufficient cause for my dismissal without advanced notice.

Volunteer Contract

I, _____ (name of volunteer), as a volunteer of Save Our Streets Ministries, understand and agree to comply with the following statements and procedures:

1. I understand that I am a volunteer, not an employee of S.O.S. Ministries.
2. I have read and agree to uphold the S.O.S. Statement of Faith.
3. I have completed and turned in an Application to Volunteer.
4. As a Christian, I represent Christ at all times, in all places, and as a volunteer of S.O.S., I also represent the ministry as a whole, its staff, board of directors, and other volunteers.
5. Ultimately, I am responsible to God for my actions and service, and therefore will refrain from any conduct, in word, attitude, or deed, that would violate or call into question the integrity of my relationship with Christ, or that would compromise the integrity of S.O.S.
6. While serving within a specific area of ministry of S.O.S. (i.e.- Children's Ministry, Women's Ministry, Bus Ministry, etc.), I agree to:
 - Submit to the designated authority, director, or other persons assigned to leadership positions.
 - Meet all the attendance policies as determined by each department of ministry.
 - Follow all policies, procedures, and / or guidelines as set by S.O.S. or leadership personnel.
7. I have read the attached forms regarding how to detect and report child abuse and understand that the suspicion of child abuse and / or neglect requires immediate action. Failing to take the appropriate action bears serious legal consequences and could further compromise the safety of the individual in question. If, at any time, an attendant of S.O.S. activities under the age of 18 reports they are experiencing abuse or neglect to me, or if I have reason to suspect that they are experiencing abuse or neglect, I will immediately:
 - Notify the director of the specific area of ministry I serve under (Children's Director, Women's Director, etc.). In the event that they cannot be reached, I will notify J.J. Ramirez or Carmen Maxwell.
 - Take further appropriate legal and personal action as determined through consultation with that previously mentioned S.O.S. staff member, including, but not limited to, contacting the local police department and CPS to report the abuse.
8. I am aware of the hazards and risks to my person and property associated with serving with S.O.S. at formal S.O.S. activities, such as, but not limited to, Thursday night activities, Friday night services, etc., and / or informal activities, such as, but not limited to, injury, disease, criminal activity, and random acts of violence.
9. S.O.S. encourages volunteers to be involved with the personal lives of those we are serving. However, because of the nature of the ministry conducted by S.O.S., it is necessary to keep extensive and accurate records of all activities. Additionally, we recognize that our battle is not with flesh and blood (Ephesians 6:12). The staff and Board of Directors of S.O.S. not only want to aid in maintaining your physical safety, but your spiritual safety as well.

- These guidelines will provide legal and personal accountability for me, as well as S.O.S. as a whole. Also, contacting those in leadership within S.O.S. will aid in the provision of the spiritual support (prayer, etc.) needed to address the difficult nature of the ministry conducted by S.O.S.

I have read and understand all of the above and agree to comply with all of the aforementioned statements and procedures. I will not hold S.O.S. Ministries or any of its staff, volunteers, or Board of Directors responsible for any injuries suffered or property destroyed. I further waive my right to sue or claim damages against S.O.S. Ministries, its staff, volunteers, or Board of Directors for any reason.

Statement of Faith

1. We believe in one God, creator and sustainer of the universe, who eternally exists in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
