

20TH ANNUAL BANQUET

This year's banquet, "Rise", on Tuesday, October 5th, was an evening to remember! Over 550 people from diverse cultural, denominational, and socioeconomic backgrounds gathered to hear about SOS Ministries and worship the good God whose power has made the last 28 years of service possible. It is in the DNA of SOS Ministries to encourage people to RISE and answer what God has planned for them. We are so arateful to God and this community that allowed us to raise OVER \$180,000!

28 years ago, God gave JJ Ramirez a vision of a 24/7 facility," It's multigenerational, selfless in execution, almost impossible in its fulfillment, frightening ramifications of its failure. Its focus is daunting, and

its impact is clear." 28years later, "this land is being used for the glory and the purposes of God...we stayed with the vision, we have not diverted from it."

SOS has a front row seat in seeing life transformation and we were able to share three personal stories of God's miracles and saving power in people's lives. We heard the

Newman family's story of how God's love, patience, and faithfulness has worked through SOS for so many years. "There is peace in SOS. Everybody here wants to see you grow and get better in life. It's a blessing to see how our kids know and love God. This ministry is like their second home." Tony, their teenage son, also shared his story. "Since I was younger, I've seen JJ as a role model. He's always influenced me to search more for God and to be a leader to tell others about God, and if there isn't a group to lead, then I'll have to make one." The next story was for Lance. He told us how God saved him in the midst of being lost to addiction and crime. "The only way I knew to numb the pain was to drink or snort it away. I was lost and broken, and then God said that's enough." Lance had an encounter with Jesus while he was in prison. "While watching a movie in prison, all the

pain I had inside just flooded out. Everybody around me began praying for. That is where I felt Jesus and I can only thank God for that...I'm thankful JJ did not give up on me. Now it's time for me to go back and help others who are lost and broken." The last story was Felicia's. She spoke about the power of prayers she received from the Women's Ministry at the darkest moment in her life. "Last year in August, I had a suicide attempt. I thought I was going to die. I was sent to a mental hospital for a week, and that's when I began coming back to SOS. It's a blessing to have a family like SOS that no only prays for you, but also locks arms to fight with you. God is really opening the floodgates of Heaven for me and my

kids because I'm being obedient. I know I'm not perfect and never will be, but I don't allow my mistakes to keep me on the ground. I pray about it and get back up."

JJ also preached that we need to "rise up" and "do as the occasion demands (1 Samuel 10:7)". He urged us to believe no matter what happens in the unprecedented time we're living, the

word of God is true. He encouraged us to rise in their faith, confidence, and courage. "We are all a part of this story. The Lord has given us all a reason why we are here. We are here to live for the Kingdom and glory of God. We are here to play and not just sit on the sidelines. "This is our finest hour. We must rise and believe we are standing for the glory of God."

Our Bus Ministry also serves as a vital tool in training men and women during our Commercial Driver's License (CDL) semester of the Jack Threadgill Vocational Training Program. Over 30 students have successfully graduated from this program since it began in 2019 and our Bus Ministry gives us the opportunity to hire these graduates as we support them on their individual journeys to lasting life change. Additionally, driving buses and vans throughout the Brazos Valley increases awareness of our ministry and grants us more time to spend in at-risk neighborhoods building relationships with families and discovering effective ways to meet present, tangible needs.
