For over 28 years of ministry in the Brazos Valley, SOS Ministries has carried out the mission to "Rescue, Restore, and Release" families from drug and gang infested environments where abuse, poverty, & violence have been a way of life. Since the beginning, we have witnessed God perform countless miracles through our outreaches in at-risk neighborhoods across the community where not just one life was transformed, but entire families' generational cycles of poverty, hurt, and abuse were broken.

Our recent outreach at Saddlewood Apartment Complex began by receiving calls from the apartment managers. They were desperate about all the random shootings and violence that was going on and needed SOS to bring the love, peace and presence of Jesus

there. In the words of JJ Ramirez: "The Lord began to put the same gut feeling I had back in 1993 inside of me and called me to go back out there. So we began praying and asking God for strategy during out Thursday night Bible Study. I called anybody that felt they were a son or a daughter to this Ministry to join us

because I believe God is on the move to raise up the next generation of the Kingdom's Children."

With hearts filled with the courage, love and peace of Christ, SOS Ministries took an army of believers to Saddlewood. We broke up into teams with each team reaching out to a certain number of apartments. Each team was shared the love of Christ with the residents, prayed and blessed their home, and offered to buy Christmas gifts for over the 200 children that live in the Saddlewood apartments. Every Thursday evening for a month, we went back with hopes and prayers to share the Gospel with each household and bring Kingdom love to them.

JJ adds: "Our vision is to go to neighborhoods like

Saddlewood and be pastors there. And through that, we can raise a new generation of pastors and leaders to do what I did with the gangs 30 years ago. This way, we will raise people that are not only productive for the society they live in, but also productive to the Kinadom of God. What we are called to do in Saddlewood, and all across the Brazos Valley, is to raise up an army that is the walking manifestation of John 15:13 and is willing to go out there. Whatever time you're called upon by the Lord is the moment to rise up and act. Our calling as a church is to be a tangible expression of God's unconditional love so that we may witness these people's walk toward the Lord and their growth in faith. As the church, we are to keep believing, praying, and hoping for the next generation to rise up

and take the torch. I am only ONE man, so this is on ALL OF US to raise the next generation with the heart of Christ to go into these communities and see if the Lord is calling them to be the father to the fatherless, to defend the case of the widow, and so much more."

As we continue to build relationships, we will deliver Christmas presents door to door at Saddlewood and pray with the families as God provides opportunities. THANK YOU to First Financial Bank for their partnership with us to provide Christmas gifts.
