While handing out BBQ plates at Peppertree, God led us to a women who had lost her husband in a recent shooting. Before we left, the wife's father walked in the room with tears in his eyes and said, "I could feel God's presence

when you entered our home. Thank you for coming in to pray."

Also at Peppertree, we met a woman who broke down in tears when the SOS volunteers asked her if she needed any prayer. She responded," Yes, pray against my addiction". As we prayed for generational curses to be

broken and for this woman to return to the Father, her countenance was completely changed. She lifted up her head and told us she was ready to give her life to the Lord.

One of the volunteers from our Women's Ministry beautifully testified to God's work in her life as she invited a friend of hers from Peppertree to our Women's Tuesday Night Bible Study! Praise God that the woman got to see our volunteer be transformed by the love of Jesus!

The Block Party at Saddlewood Apartments was also an amazing sign of God's work! As we

walked around Saddlewood praying and inviting people to join, we saw a lady and her friend on a wheelchair. We invited them to come to the Block Party, and they said yes! After hearing JJ's message and several people sharing their stories, they both felt led to go to the front and receive Jesus in their hearts!

As JJ called people forward, children and adults began to come to give their lives to Jesus and receive Him. As we circled around them to pray for God's saving grace to come, over those, we saw a tiny, little boy by himself. With his hands cupped, eyes closed looking to heaven, and tears running down his face, he was praying to receive Jesus. It

was absolutely a holy moment and a reminder that the Gospel is truly the power of God for salvation for everyone who believes, even those the rest of this world would overlook
