In the words of one of our volunteers at Saddlewood, "I spoke to a woman who recently was displaced from her home in Louisiana and did not have any family in town. I partnered with her in prayer, encouraged her to join our Women's Ministry, and watched her face light up once I told her of our plans to have weekly Bible Studies at Saddlewood. The message of God's unending love & Hope shared by our speakers provided an opportunity for people to receive the Gospel and for us to continue sowing seeds into the community." In the words of JJ Ramirez: "More than anything else, S.O.S. Ministries is an outreach ministry. This is the time to let the world know who Jesus is so they can transformed, healed and restored through him. There are so many hurting souls out there that have never experienced the love and hope of Christ. We need to show them the love of Christ in words, and more importantly, in our actions. It is the heart of our Father that none should perish, and this is what gives us the strength to take Jesus to those who need healing and restoration though Him." The heart of this capital campaign is simple: enable more women, men, and children for generations to come to experience the strength and love of God through the vision and ministry of S.O.S. In the words of Carmen Maxwell, our Assistant Director, "The people of S.O.S. Ministries have truly experienced

the resurrection power of Jesus... and that is the power that fans the flame that ignites the next generation."

Our goal is to raise \$6.5M dollars over three years to expand our programs and facilities to widen our reach and deepen our impact

for Jesus in the community. We are thrilled to announce we have already raised \$4.2M towards our goal! Doug French, Campaign Chair, says, "When I think about the future of S.O.S., I think about growth. I think about opportunity and I think about impact. As we build up more and more capacity with facilities, infrastructure, including staff... the impact that S.O.S. will have in this community, through God, is going to continue to increase."

This campaign allows us to serve our community in many ways, including the following:

• Add 10,000 square feet to our main building for additional classroom space.

• Grow our vocational training program by adding 5,000 square feet of devoted space.

• Add much-needed additional space for our ministry and administrative team.

• Build a new road through the property that will make a major impact in our freedom to function and grow.

• Add "Carmen's Prayer Garden" at the center of our property, to continually provide praise and seek strength from the source of our Hope.

• Increase staff & funding for our programs that proclaim the Gospel, disciple believers, &

equip those we reach with the life & vocational skills needed to thrive.

• Add a commercial kitchen and updated renovations to our existing space to further meet the needs of those we serve.

The next chapter in our growth is God continuing to make good on His

promise to do what many consider impossible. JJ adds, "We are building something that will stay here long after I am gone. That way, we can instill the next generation with even greater passion to be ignited for the glory of God...We are bringing sons and daughters in our ministry, to do far greater than we can even think."
