As we prepare to celebrate 30 years of ministry, we remember our good God's faithfulness and transforming revival through the testimonies from years past. Meet Dan, one of the residents at our Men's Home Discipleship Program. God has written an incredible story of redemption, revival, healing & transformation in his life displaying His love & grace:

Before I was saved by God's grace, my life was filled with crippling anxiety. I was a slave to drugs. All I wanted was to get up, get high, and keep repeating this endless cycle. I did not want to do anything else. I got myself into a relationship and things began going downhill

from there. She was addicted to meth. I remember the first time I tried meth I broke down into tears. I knew I would not be the same again. The endless me such a wealth cycle of drugs kept staying the same and my girlfriend ended up getting pregnant.

My first child was born

with traces of meth in his system, so CPS got involved. My girlfriend & I tried many times to quit, but wé just couldn't. It was really sad. I thought I was going to die that way.

l remember getting a text message from our daughter's adoptive family. They told me she had passed away. After that, everything turned dark, and I relapsed. I tried to stop using drugs, but it was short-lived. I felt like I had nothing and no one left. I felt alone. I struggled to fill the void with everything and anyone. I was trying to build a relationship to gain what I had lost. It wasn't until the Lord saved & delivered me from drugs that I

realized He was always there for me. It was me who kept pushing Him away. Where God wanted to be the Lord of my life, it was ME who kept insisting to be the Lord of my own life.

Coming to the SOS Men's Home has fully transformed my life. God has healed my heart towards my kids and the people around me. I was so rebellious before joining the Men's Home and tried to avoid responsibilities. I am now thankful for the responsibilities that are given to me. I look forward to fulfilling every task at hand and try my best to live up to what God brings my way. God has given me a wealth of joy & peace, and I feel at home

at SÓS. I'thank Jesus for the trust that JJ & everyone else have in me. It's so good to finally have big brothers I could look up to, brothers who are not going to steer me in the wrong direction or treat me poorly. I thank JJ for being a great teacher and being there for me. I'm thankful that he has taken the fathership role

because my actual father did not do a good job. I know I have a future now. I don't know what God has for me in the future, but I'm lookina forward to it.

We were blessed to have Dan share his testimony during last year's banquet. Dan is now preparing to graduate from the Men's home to a full-time position in Pecos. Please join us in prayer for him and the new chapter he is about to start in his life! God is so faithful, and we are confident His promise of revival will continue to pass in Dan's life, and in the lives of all those throughout our community!

Since the program began in 2019, we have trained OVER 120 men & women in a highly employable trade (either plumbing, welding, or earning their CDL-B) and equipped them with financial and relational skills to build better lives for their families!
