

Teen Boys Ministry

Our Teen Boys Ministry continues to make a powerful impact, serving over 30-40 young men each week. The teens gather for weekly Bible study, where dedicated volunteers walk them through Scripture, helping them apply it to their daily lives. Afterward, they break into small groups for deeper discussion and prayer, followed by time to play basketball or connect one-on-one with leaders about life's challenges.

We believe in real life discipleship. Brandon, our teen boys ministry leader, regularly takes boys to local sporting events like Aggie baseball and basketball games, and even more importantly, brings boys to church who've decided to start attending. Just last week, a group went fishing in Somerville after the Sunday service and were able to go over questions about the book of Titus!

This past April, over 15 boys and leaders took a fishing trip—one of our big events of the semester! It was more than just fishing, it was a meaningful time of connection, share, listen to the Gospel, and reflect. It was a time of mentorship that our teens need. Almost every boy caught a fish! This annual trip is just one of many opportunities our teens have to build relationships and grow in faith during the year.

"These kids are hungry for the Lord," Brandon says. "They're diving into Bible studies and asking real questions about the gospel. I can see Jesus working in their hearts—He has something big in store." Brandon also ministers biweekly at JDC (Juvenile Detention Center), where teen boys are beginning to show deeper curiosity about Jesus. A few of the boys are so impacted that they begin coming to regular Thursday night bible studies once they are released.

A couple of our leaders regularly visit teens they're mentoring at DAEP, a disciplinary school for middle and high school students. They make frequent visits to start new relationships and build on old ones. We continue to pursue them, just as Christ pursues the Church. We're calling them back—back home, and forward into more of what God has for them in His Kingdom.

Taking Jesus to the Streets Awareness Month Recap 2025

During this year's Awareness Month, God made a way for our ministry to have three outreach events at Sandy Creek Apartments, Peppertree Neighborhood, and Columbus Village Apartments in Hearne. We went door to door to pray for each resident and spread the love of Jesus. The following week, we held a Block Party in each neighborhood featuring music, food, incredible testimonies, fellowship, and prayer! Later in April, SOS volunteers and staff prepared and delivered OVER 500 BBQ plates to Peppertree and Canyon Village and spent time in fellowship and prayer with the residents.

I believe that God will bring divine transformation to these neighborhoods in the way that only He can.

The outreach at Sandy Creek Apartments was also an amazing sign of God's work! People stepped out in faith to receive Jesus. Jenna, a volunteer, shared, "Kids were so excited to accept the Lord into their hearts. They were excited to get bibles and hear more- they just wanted more of God. I was so moved by their willingness to say yes to Jesus, and it was a great reminder of what having faith like a child really means."

God continues to bless our BBQ Outreaches! Carmen, our Women's Ministry leader, told us about a woman who was driving by and saw SOS volunteers handing out plates. "She said, 'I was putting all my money together

and I had a dollar and twenty five cents. I was going to see how much food I could buy for my kids.' There were four young children in the car, and we gave all of them a full meal. As we prayed for her, she reached back and held her children as the tears came down her face. There was just so much pain

in the streets, so much heartache, so many hard stories. I'm just grateful to God that we get to step out there and represent Jesus. My prayer is that Jesus will answer every one of the prayers that were spoken out there, and I believe that God will bring divine transformation to these

neighborhoods in the way that only He can."

We thank God for the opportunity to reach out during our Awareness Month. Hearts received the Good News of the Gospel and people confessed their desire to have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ!
