# JJ'S VISION FOR 2026

I am excited about the opportunities God has for us in 2026 to speak and show the love of Jesus in bold ways. 2026 is not about rushing ahead or striving in our own strength, but about learning to rest in His presence. God is calling us to let go of worry, slow down, and realign our hearts with His voice. When we rest in the presence of the Lord, we find clarity, peace, and the ability to do more with less.

God is calling us into deeper connection with Him. In the Hebrew Calendar, the number six represents connection. This is a divine year of connectivity. God is shaping our hearts so our praying, thinking, and doing are all aligned with Him. This kind of intimacy may require painful disconnections from habits or distractions that pull our attention away from God. Even though these disconnections may be hard, it always leads to deeper dependence on the Lord.

Intimacy with Christ is essential. Romans 10:14-17 reminds us that faith comes by hearing. If we don't hear right, we can't speak right. We are living in what I like to call "the decade of the voice" and that makes intimacy even more important. In a culture filled with noise and opinions, only those who know His voice will speak with wisdom, truth, and authority.

There will be times of uncertainty and shaking in our lives, but scripture reminds us in Haggai that God will shake the Heavens and the earth, not to destroy, but to awaken. Revival is already here. Intimacy with Christ will keep us steady when everything else feels unstable. We can't be distracted by the shaking, we must keep our eyes fixed on Jesus and remain anchored in the Truth.

To walk through this season with confidence, we must gain spiritual authority that flows from intimacy with God. Like the disciples in Luke 11, we must ask, "Lord, teach us to pray." When we focus on intimacy with God and our prayer life, we gain spiritual authority that is talked about in Mark 1:21-28.

Let us make 2026 the year to grow in intimacy with God as we rest in His presence and gain authority of the kingdom of Heaven. We are excited to see the how God is going to use SOS to bring awakening, healing, and transformation to the Brazos Valley in 2026!
